Outreach Activities 2019 – 2020

- On March 2, 2019 Chris Musial attended the Buffalo Broadcasters Association Broadcasting Job Fair at the Millennium Hotel to inform interested professionals about WBBZ and potential opportunities with the station.
- On September 18, 2019 Chris Musial participated in a panel discussion held by the Medaille College Alumni Association and the TRiO Student Support Services Program. The panel shared career insights with the students
- On October 7, 2019 Catherine Miller participated in a panel of notable broadcast professionals for students at Daeman College. In this event students learned important information from media professionals who have grown their careers through the many technical advancements, challenges and changes in the media landscape throughout the years.
- On November 20, 2019 Chatham Marcolini participated as a panelist for the Medaille College Communication Program annual alumni panel luncheon. Discussion centered around the careers of the panelist and offered current students opportunities to meet professionals who are advanced in the industry and ask questions.
- On December 2, 2019 Catherine Miller was requested to speak with a Media Studies group at in the Buffalo State College Media Department. She discussed the unique landscape as navigated by a woman in what had previously been primarily a man's industry.
- On December 16, 2019 students from Nardin Academy visited WBBZ for a tour and to learn how a live TV program is produced. Students participated as on-camera subjects during the experience.
- On January 16, 2020 Account Executives from WBBZ-TV attended a webinar from the Media Audit on Demographic Research. In this session, Beverly Lolande discussed how to research and develop the necessary information to best serve WBBZ customers to reach their marketing goals.
- WBBZ-TV is committed to giving college students a hands-on internship experience that includes working on local station productions, social media promotion, event coordination and general assignments.

WBBZ-TV has officially reached out to internship coordinators at Medaille College; the University at Buffalo; Buffalo State College; Canisius College, Niagara County Community college; Erie Community College, and Daemen College seeking interns. WBBZ-TV has also fielded inquiries from students at other colleges interested in participating with the station.

In 2019 WBBZ-TV offered a diverse group of students an opportunity to learn and grow at our independent television station.

WBBZ-TV hosted an intern from Medaille College.

Description: Interns for WBBZ-TV work on many projects tied to locally-produced programs and commercials. Interns have an opportunity to get "hands on" experience with studio and remote field cameras for live productions. Interns assist in producing segments, booking guests, social

media promotion and doing research for a variety of subjects ranging from sports to public affairs. In addition, interns get an opportunity to work with the Sales Department in understanding the business of television and interacting with clients.
